**FOR CONTROL OF GREENHOUSE WHITEFLY IN PROTECTED TOMATOES**

## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Product to be used:

APPLAUD INSECTICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 440 g/L BUPROFEZIN as the only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

Crop Type	Insect Pest	Application Rate
TOMATOES Protected cropping situations only	Greenhouse whitefly ( <i>Trialeurodes vaporariorum</i> )	Apply 30 mL product / 100 L water

### Critical Use Comments:

- Apply two (2) applications at 7-10 day interval as soon as pest appears in the crop.
- Ensure good coverage, especially to the underside of leaves.
- Apply by foliar spray using appropriately calibrated equipment.
- DO NOT exceed more than two (2) applications per crop per season.

### Withholding Period:

DO NOT HARVEST FOR 3 DAYS AFTER LAST APPLICATION.

### Jurisdiction:

ACT, NSW, QLD, SA, TAS, NT and WA only.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their *Control-of-Use* legislation does not require a permit to legalise this off-label use in this state.

### Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use the products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the permit particularly the information included in DETAILS OF PERMIT and CONDITIONS OF PERMIT.

### Export of Produce:

Exported produce or animals must have appropriate residue tolerance limits established in the importing countries and any residues must not exceed the tolerance limits.
